A COUPLE OF [RELATIVELY] OLD BOOKS TO READ

I was looking at my shelf of books that I have read over the past three years, and I noticed a couple in particular that I had not seen or thought about in quite a while. These are two books that helped stimulate the early growth stages of my political awareness.

The first one is a book by Lawrence Eubank called <u>The Case Against Capital</u>. What I like about this book is that it completely refutes Marxist economic theory (and what is not to like about that?). While the fall of the Soviet Union pretty much collapsed all serious consideration of his political theory, the challenges against capitalism have largely been accepted as truths that have converted many a university student to the Left. This is the best serious work I have read that has thrown Marxist economic thinking to the trash heap of history. Lawrence Eubank, by far, committed me to my own disgust with communism.
